How do I know if the product I'm buying is counterfeit?

**Some indicators to watch for:**

- the price is much lower than average
- spelling mistakes on the product or packaging
- products normally sold in packages being sold individually
- shoddy appearance of the product or package
- products (particularly electrical products) that have no name brand
